

Resolution #2 of 2018
Town of Olive
Local Consultation Response for NYCDEP Parcel ID #286

WHEREAS, the Town of Olive, through the City of New York’s Land Acquisition Local Consultation Process, received notification that the City of New York proposes acquisition of a Watershed Conservation Easement for SBL 45.4-2-58, 59 & 60 (aka Parcel ID #286) totaling +/- 137.1 acres; and

WHEREAS, the Town has 120 days to review and respond to this submission regarding the City’s adherence to the MOA and its recommendations for public access; and

WHEREAS, there are no security and/or safety issues since the easement does not grant public access to the property and Section 5 of the proposed brief summary of the Conservation Easement states the “Grantor retains signification recreational rights to the Easement Property (hunting, hiking fishing, etc.), controls public access to the property and retains the right to sell, transfer or encumber the property subject to the CE.”

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Town of Olive Town Board supports and agrees with the reserve rights of the grantor to control public access and recreational usage of Parcel ID #286.
